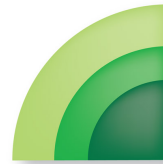

# Pedalling long way for cancer support

ENVIRONMENTAL company Insight Environmental is doing its bit to help local communities by helping raise funds for cancer victims.

General manager Clare Kuzich is participating in this year's 800km SolarisCare Red Sky Ride from Perth to raise awareness and funds for the SolarisCare Foundation.

Her 22 team members will test their physical and mental endurance over eight days from Sunday, March 1.

The team will be supported by eight volunteers and five support vehicles as it cycles from Perth to York, Narrogin, Kojonup, Bridgetown, Bunbury and Mandurah, before finishing in Perth.

None of the team are professional cyclists but they have been in training

since October and are now each riding more than 300km a week in preparation for the ride.

The SolarisCare Foundation was founded in 2001 to provide support to cancer victims, their families and carers in WA.

It provides a safe and welcoming place where cancer patients and their carers can visit to receive information and choose therapeutic treatment from 15 complementary therapies that are provided by volunteer professional therapists.

SolarisCare is self-funded and the Red Sky Ride founders want to raise \$1 million over five years to assist the service.

"Most of us have been touched in some way by cancer, by personal experience, by caring for or about someone with cancer or by just being very grate-

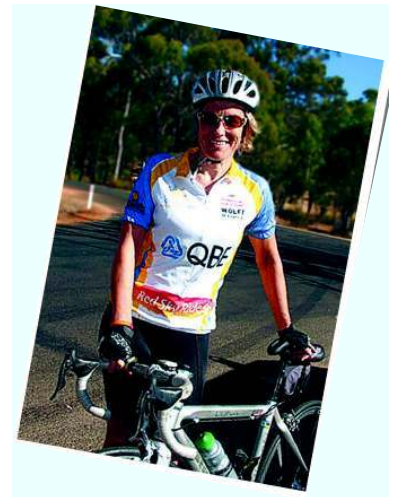
ful that none of the above applies to us," Ms Kuzich said.

"Each participant in the SolarisCare Red Sky Ride commits to raising funds and I am asking you here for your support.

"Whilst we are all aware that the current economic climate is making the going tougher for most businesses, and there are challenges ahead for all of us, I hope you'll agree that this does not compare with the challenges faced by patients and their families when faced with a cancer diagnoses."
